Greetings from the Careers Department

We trust you are all doing well.

Further to our email dated 2nd April 2020 we plan to start with the SOP/Essay writing sessions which will be lead by Mr. Anthony Skillicorn whom most of you would remember meeting last year. Mr. Skillicorn grew up in apartheid South Africa and was educated there and at Balliol College, Oxford University. He has lived and taught in Africa, England, and from 1987 - 2013 in Asia where he successfully transformed the United World College of South East Asia's Global Concerns programme into a much-admired model of genuine student empowerment. As Head of the IB boarding and an IB teacher and tutor at UWCSEA Anthony Skillicorn was closely involved with the university application process. In 2018 he advised candidates from international schools applying to Oxbridge. Anthony Skillicorn has also been closely involved with all aspects of the UWCSEA Service Programmes and was instrumental in starting the Initiative for Peace programme which has trained IB Diploma students to bring young people from areas of conflict

together to promote reconciliation and youth leadership. Anthony Skillicorn has spoken at various IB, Round Square, and ECIS conferences on service. He has contributed articles to several periodicals and books and is featured in a number of articles. In 2010 he published Service is a Journey which discusses the importance of service to educational institutions. Since retiring from UWCSEA Anthony Skillicorn has acted as a consultant to many international schools.

After the sessions, we will be sharing the notes and videos with you all to help you get started. We will also be sharing some more resources to help you understand the technicalities of writing your sop/essays better.
